# Registration Enhancements

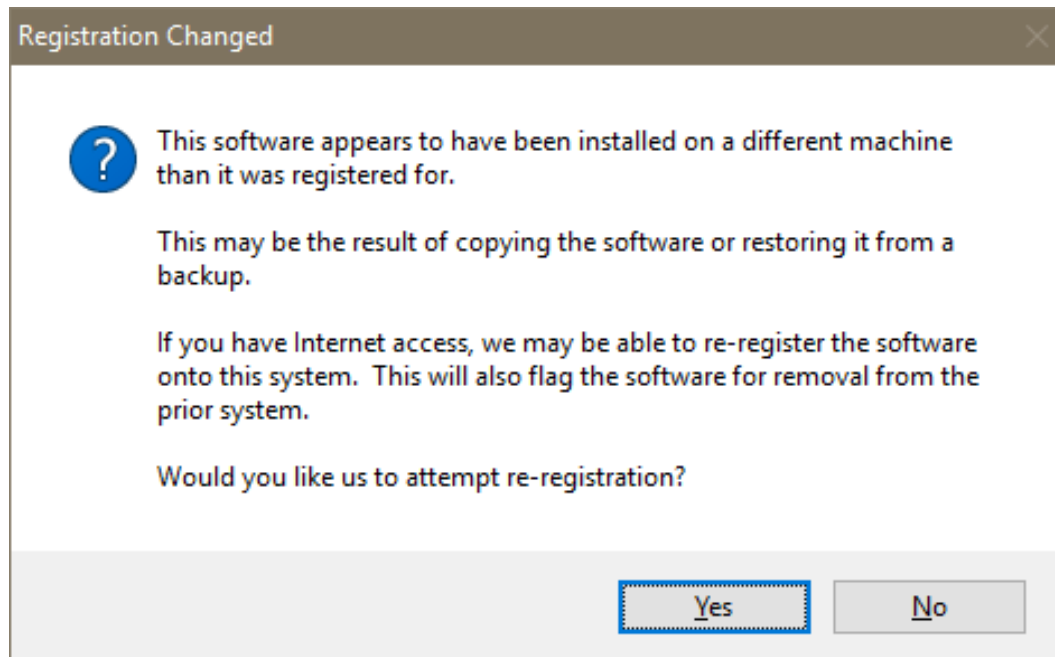
## Current logic

- Registration of PxPlus license
  - Activation key provided for initial install
  - Registration must be done within 30 days
  - Registration locks license to OS and disk
    - Cannot move PxPlus to new system
    - Contact PVX Plus Technologies to re-register
- During 2017 introduced a 'Move' process
  - Re-run online registration to decommission on current system
  - Run online registration to install on new system

# Registration Enhancements

## Emergency Transfer

- Automatic detection of 'moved' systems
  - Allows for registration on new server
  - Minimizes effort required to re-register



# Registration Enhancements

## Improved Connectivity

- Firewalls can prevent online registration
  - Registration helps us and our resellers track use of software and applications
  - Provides valuable input for our support staff
    - What version is running
    - What OS and Packages
- Running **\*plus/reg/net** registers product
  - PxPlus 2016 added ability to route request through WindX
    - Uses WindX Internet connection to register
  - PxPlus 2018 adds support for Windows proxy
    - Uses **wininet** DLL to make connection

# License Management

- Addressed problem with multiple installs
  - User counts could go against wrong license
    - Logic done with internal Windows objects
  - Revised user count allocation scheme
    - Tied properly to the ACTIVATE.PVX file
    - Similar to methods used on Linux/Unix
    - Not Compatible with prior releases

User licenses are not shared between PxPlus 2017 and prior releases. Single workstation running multiple pre-2017 versions will count as two users.
