SFTP File Upload/Downloads



- Similar in function to FTP
 - SFTP uses SSH for communication
 - SSH allows for Private/Public key authentication, as well as password authentication.
 - Private/Public key authentication will be attempted first before password authentication.
 - More secure than FTP and only requires SSH on host
 - Logic internally uses 'curl' to perform transfer
 - CURL provided with Windows install
 - Comes pre-installed with most Linux builds

To Receive/Upload a file

 CALL "*WEB/SFTP;RECEIVE", server\$, user\$, password\$, key_path\$, key_passphrase\$, insecure, timeout, files_to_receive\$, download_dir\$, case\$, result\$

To List a directory

• CALL "*WEB/SFTP;LIST", server\$, user\$, password\$, key_path\$, key_passphrase\$, insecure, timeout, recursion, result\$

To Delete a file

• CALL "*WEB/SFTP;DELETE", server\$, user\$, password\$, key_path\$, key_passphrase\$, insecure, timeout, recursion, result\$
